SEVEN DAYS LUXURY YACHT CHARTER CRUISING BALEARIC ISLANDS FROM AND TO IBIZA



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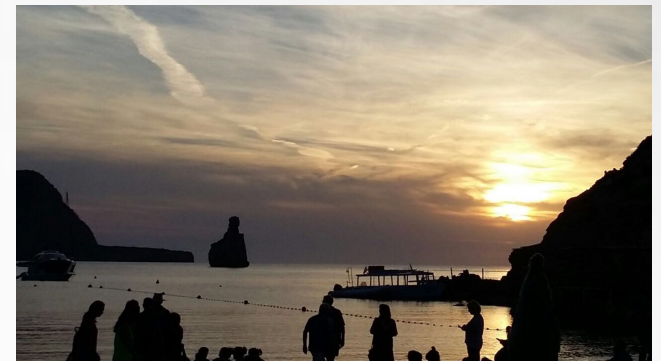
Day 1

The ideal starting point for your cruise is **Marina Ibiza**. Porroig is a beautiful and peaceful bay placed in an exclusive area of the island. You will only have to leave time go by, maybe at anchor at Blue Marlin Beach Club in Cala Jondal. Meeting point of famous and beautiful people, it is the perfect place to drink a cocktail, start enjoying with style the real rhythm of Ibiza and have a delicious lunch. Ibiza holds the crown as the Mecca for all things hedonistic and wild. You have recharged enough energy to spend the rest of the day diving into turquoise Ibiza's waters. Have dinner and get ready for unforgettable Ibiza's nightlife; the Island comes alive at night and sleeps by day. As well as infinite clubs and Boutiques Ibiza is also famed for its World Heritage sites and picture perfect houses. Night at Marina Ibiza or at anchor.



Day 2

Start your day with a rich breakfast and then visit *Cala Portinatx* which is at the foot of the mountain surrounded by forest and offers three sandy beaches and crystal clear water. This superb location is perfect for snorkeling, diving and windsurfing. Enjoy a tasty lunch at *Restaurant Cas Mallorqui*, Cala Portinatx. Not only you will enjoy the views of its privileged location, but also you will be able to taste the freshly caught fish by two fishing boats of the area. Evening in *Cala Benirras*, a blank spot where you can enjoy a spectacular sunset and, if the weather permits, anchor for dinner and overnight.





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Day 3

Have breakfast and head out to **Formentera**, an Idyllic and virgin Island. In complete contrast to non stop Ibiza and Cosmopolitan Mallorca, Formentera offers total relaxation and beauty to anyone that visits her. The Island is full of Caribbean-esque beaches and undiscovered coves such as *Illetas Beach* considered one of the most beautiful beaches of the Mediterranean, a heavenly place where you can dive in turquoise waters. Enjoy a tasty lunch at *Restaurant Juan y Andrea*. A must for people who appreciate good food and good life. You will have lunch at one of the tables located on the same beach, in the shade of the awnings. After lunch chill while sunbathing on the deck of your yacht and experience water toys available onboard. Have a drink watching the sunset. Dinner onboard. Night at anchor or in the marina.



Day 4

Mallorca is the largest of the four islands of the Balearic Archipelago and is a vivid and diverse Island that offers a wide variety of activities from dining in Michelin starred restaurants, watersports, culture, shopping and over 21 golf courses to choose from. With its beautiful beaches from *Es Trenc* to *Cala Mesquida* you can find everything here to satisfy your needs.. *Cala de Sa Fon* is one of the most beautiful bays in the surroundings, where you will wake up and spend the morning. Lunch aboard. In Palma de Mallorca you can visit the beautiful Cathedral, or stroll through the lovely town and do some shopping. Restaurant Nassau Beach Club in Port of Portitxol offers an international cuisine very well elaborated and after dinner you can enjoy a cocktail in the chill out area of the same restaurant.





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Day 5

Cala Formentor is one of the most beautiful spots of **Majorca island** and as a result, is very popular. It's situated in the north west of Majorca, on the Bay of Pollenca and is a Blue Flag beach. It's a spectacle to look how the pines almost take a bath into the clear waters ... This beach is ideal for relaxation and water skiing. Lunch aboard. Enjoy a delicious dinner at Restaurant The Garden, Port of Alcudia, suitable for foodies and gourmets. The Castro family will make you enjoy traditional Majorcan cuisine.



Day 6

Menorca is the second largest Island of the archipelago. It boasts a rich culture and history spanning back centuries. Menorca offers a more relaxing atmosphere, with many traditional fiestas and fantastic beaches. Take some time to visit Cala Trebeluja, a virgin spot only accessible from the sea, where you might want to take a swim, relax and spend the rest of the day. Those more adventurous can take the kayak and follow the river of fresh water that flows onto the beach, where with a little luck you can see turtles, fish and spot several species of birds. Lunch aboard. You can maybe have dinner in one of the most popular Restaurants of the island, *Restaurant S'Espigó* in Port of Mahon. It can be defined as an indispensable appointment with gastronomy and as a welcoming place, where most exquisite seafood dishes of the island are prepared. Night at anchor.





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Day 7

After breakfast onboard, visit *Cala Pudenta*, a dream cove where you can take the first swim of the day. Cala Pudenta is a corner full of nature, unspoiled, ideal for snorkeling. Have lunch at *Restaurant Es Cranc* in Port of Fornells; it is said that the best Mediterranean fish stews are eaten in Menorca and especially the ones in *Es Cranc*. Spend the night in Port of Mahon, a wonderful place full of life where most stores close after dinner. Ideal for walking and enjoying the atmosphere of the port as well as the handicraft products from its stores. Night at anchor or at quay.



Day 8

Have breakfast and set sails towards the disembarkation port in Ibiza. You will have plenty of time to be fascinated once again by the “Spanish Caribbean”, so enjoy your trip back to Ibiza.
