# IONIAN ISLAND, GREECE 7 DAYS

## DAY 1 LEFKADA

Embark in **Lefkada**, the wildest Greek's Ionian island. Familiarize with the crew and get acquainted with the boat and the cruise, while being accommodated in your cabins, then get ready to explore this magical island. The island of Lefkada combines turquoise sea and uncontaminated beaches with the lush green of a large mountainous area. Lefkada coasts are known as Ionian Caribbean. Clear beaches and crystalline sea, reproduce tropical view and unique landscapes; Lefkada is between the two Greek islands of Corfù and Kefalonia, known since the ancient Greeks as place dedicated to the sacrifice of lovers. Glorious beaches to visit and discover, as: *Aghios Ioannis, Pefkoulia, Egremni and Porto Katsiki*. Southern side coves are particularly suggestive while the Western side ones preserve a wild and uncontaminated aspect. After an amazing day exploring this beautiful island, savouring a glass of wine on the top deck of your yacht would be the perfect way to end your first day.



## DAY 2 LEFKADA-MEGANISSI

An exciting day is starting: have your breakfast while sailing to **Meganissi**. Discuss with the captain to draft all the activities you should not miss. Meganissi Island amazes visitors with the exotic blue colour of its beaches..



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and the impressive sea caves that have carved their way into the soft white limestone along the west coast. The biggest, and by far the most famous of these, is the Papanikolis Cave which is said to be the second largest sea cave in Greece. Choose a traditional taverna along the picturesque bays such as Minas taverna in *Abelike Bay*, or *Niagas restaurant in Port Athene bay* for your lunch, tasting the quite life of this island on a magnificent scenery: green landscapes and crystal waters. Your crew will wait for you onboard ready to delight you with a sensational aperitif, followed by a special dinner under the lights of stars. Night at quay.



### DAY 3 MEGANISSI – KALAMOS

Have your breakfast heading to the busy harbour at **Kalamos town**. Kalamos boasts a suggestive port, always used by local seamans as shelter where is easy to recognize the typical colours of Greek Ionian Islands little ports. If you prefer staying at anchor and swim off your boat, head to the south of the island and discover the big bay at Port Leone. Two ruined windmills can be seen on the southern tip of the bay, and opposite, a conspicuous yellow church nestles between the trees. There are no facilities ashore, but it is very peaceful and a lovely spot for lunchtime, swim or an overnight stop enjoying the calm of the island.



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## DAY 4 KALAMOS – KASTOS

The day after you may wish to visit the nearby **Kastos** island; disconnect from the distraction of busy modern life and immerse yourself in a tranquil, secluded and timeless environment. The small Greek island of Kastos lies 10 miles Southeast of the island of Lefkas. There is just a small harbour on the Southeast side of the island, offering safe mooring and several taverns, great to enjoy a light Greek lunch. Apart from yachtsmen, the village has few other visitors. The primary attraction of Kastos are the beaches down its eastern side, which are perfect for anchoring and swimming all day long. The western side of Kastos is sheer cliffs and rock and there are no beaches; just a small, sheltered quay at Sarakiniko where you can moor and have dinner onboard pampered by your crew. Night at quay.



## DAY 5 KASTOS - ITHACA

After breakfast, set sail and cruise few hours to get to the magical **Ithaca island**, full of history and beautiful beaches. This peaceful island is formed by two large peninsulas connected by a narrow isthmus and dotted with huge cliffs, steep mountains and extensive olive groves. It is an island for lovers of reflection and tranquility, for travellers excited by discovery, and most of all... for those in search of their own private Ithaca. The capital of Ithaca, Vathi is one of the world's largest natural harbours, a horseshoe shaped bay surrounded by restaurants specialized in Greek Mediterranean cuisine, fish and seafood.



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Have lunch and take time to relax and enjoy the special beauty of this outstanding bay. Be sure to sail to the many anchorages along this coastline, such as Akrotiri and Sarakiniko. Romantic evening either onboard your yacht or by exploring the charming coastal settlements..Night at anchor.

### DAY 6 ITHACA – SKORPIOS

Leave Ithaca after breakfast towards the private island of Skorpios, surrounded by beautiful greenery and emerald waters. Spend the day exploring the vicinities or unwind on the public beach. We recommend you to find the time for a walk through Scorpidi, a smaller island nearby that presents a marvellous natural ambience. Have your lunch onboard and lay down for a relaxing afternoon sunbathing on the upper deck of your yacht. Night at anchor.



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### DAY 7 SKORPIOS – KEFALONIA

After a rich breakfast, start your day cruising to the pretty **Kefalonia island**. An ideal choice for visitors keen to find something more traditional, tranquil and pure could be *Poros bay* on the south east coast. The town lays around the only natural crossing point of the *Vohinas river*: the combination of dense and verdant vegetation along with the crystal blue sea makes this village one of the most perfect summer destinations. High in the hills above the port, lies the *Drakaina* cave, inhabited in pre-historic times, and the remains of an ancient city, probably pre-dating the Mycenaean era.





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Lunching at anchor with this magnificent view would make your holidays memorable. Keep exploring the Greek sea bottom, ideal for snorkeling. Then get ready for a stroll around the little village of Kefalonia for an aperitif while your crew prepares dinner onboard.

### **DAY 8 BACK IN LEFKADA**

After a rich breakfast you will enjoy the last moments on the beautiful Kefalonia before sailing back to Lefkada. Visit the main town of the island, Lefkada, with a pretty maze of streets and lots of tavernas, shops and bars.



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
