

SEVEN DAYS LUXURY YACHT CHARTER CRUISING FROM NASSAU TO NASSAU

Day 1: Nassau and Paradise Island

Nassau's lively metropolis and neighboring Paradise Island stand in dramatic contrast to the tranquility and isolation of the islands and cays that await your voyage. The islands are dedicated to fun and leisure, with a profusion of resorts and boutiques, as well as the Caribbean's largest casino, the Atlantis Resort & Casino.



Day 2: Paradise Island to Warderick Wells Cay

As you approach Exuma Cays Land and Sea Park, prepare for a dive or snorkel into the underwater world of the 176-mile natural marine sanctuary known as the Garden of Eden. Explore the park headquarters while the yacht is moored in the "petting zoo." Feed the Wall-Eyed Jacks from the yacht's stern. Take advantage of the island's various walking routes.



Day 3: Waderwick Wells Cay to Staniel Cay

Continue down the Exumas and anchor off Big Major's Spot, where the swimming pigs can be found. They begin swimming casually out to the tender. They can be fed, petted, and even swam with.

The adjacent bodies of water are perfect for water sports. Move on to Staniel Cay and take the tender to the Thunderball Grotto made famous by the Bond movie of the same name and also starring in 1983 American spy film, 'Never Say Never Again'.



Day 4: Staniel Cay to Compass Cay

Take the tender to the eastern coast from Compass Cay Marina. Compass Cay is a lovely crescent-shaped beach that has been considered one of the greatest in the Bahamas. Relax in Rachel's Bubble Bath, the island's massive natural Jacuzzi. The more daring can swim with nurse sharks in Compass Cay's shallow waters.



Day 5: Compass Cay to Shroud Cay

Catch the high tide on Shroud Cay, an uninhabited archipelago of cays and rocks, then take a jet ski or tender on the legendary Mangrove Run. Snorkel in the crystal-clear creeks to see the native sanctuary fish before stepping ashore to the island's gorgeous beaches.



Day 6: Shroud Cay to Highbourne Cay

You may catch grouper, snapper, and tuna on early-morning deep-sea fishing cruises off the east shore of Highbourne Cay. Once back on board, you can relax on the deck and enjoy the sunshine or take advantage of the many options for diving and snorkeling. Just off the cay is a drop-off with a 23-meter vertical wall that is well filled with marine life. One of The Bahamas' best-kept secrets is the eight beaches of Enjoy Highbourne, which are all deserted islands of paradise that can all be reached on foot from the Marina.



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Day 7: Highbourne Cay to Allan's Cay and Nassau

Before dropping anchor and sailing to Allan's Cay, have your breakfast on the aft deck while observing rays in the water below. The center of the Cay's three islets provides a superb mooring. Local Bahamian iguanas can be spotted in the nearby shallow waters, and they'll appreciate some bananas if you give them some.

Disembarkation the following day after one more dip in the clear Bahamas waters, head back to Nassau for one last Caribbean frolic.
