Day 1: Victoria

Day 3: Praslin

After an active morning, why not carry on the theme of the day and get out the water sports equipment as the afternoon approaches? Day 4: La Digue

Visit one of the island's vanilla plantations as your first stop of the day. One of the island's principal exports is vanilla, which lends the region a lovely fragrance. As you have a tour of the plantation and get a chance to sample some of the product, inhale the tempting smell. The villagers are welcoming and eager to share their way of life and the goods they can make with ingredients they can find nearby with visitors. Take a break from shopping to enjoy a quick lunch at one of the family-run restaurants and sample some of the specialties. Enjoy a superb Michelin-style dinner on board your vessel for the remainder of the evening, followed by beverages and starry skies.



Day 5: Desroches

You may have an amazing day on this island, but the seas can get a little rocky and there is no shelter from the wind. Get into your diving gear and explore the spectacular reefs that adorn the island of Desroches. The coast is covered in beautiful corals. Keep a look out for larger guests like rays and reef sharks while observing the hundreds of fish darting in and out of the rock formations. There is a little fishing resort with a few facilities you can use. If you plan to spend some time tanning, use the sun loungers if you don't feel like lying on the sand. After drying off in the sun and sipping on some different beverages, head back to your yacht for some spa time and therapeutic treatments.



Day 6: St Joseph

The majority of the day will be spent in the water, but if you're up for some heart-pounding excitement, there will be plenty of time to get out the water toys. Dive in the lagoon first thing in the morning to view the plethora of aquatic life that calls this place home. To get some amazing underwater footage, keep your wits about you since little breeds of sharks and rays frequent this area. A few sandy islets surround the lagoon of St. Joseph, which is two miles wide. After your dive, relax with a quick lunch on one of the islands before getting back in the water or getting the toys out. Unwind with feast of a beach barbeque with cushions, throws and an unbeatable sunset over the Indian Ocean.



Day 7: Victoria

As the last full day onboard it's unfortunately also the last chance to make the most of diving, snorkelling and exploring the waters surrounding and lay on the beach for a last tan top up. Alternatively, after a leisurely lunch on board go in to the town to do some shopping and pick up souvenirs for family and friends. Spend the rest of the afternoon tasting delicious canapes, cocktails, swimming and sunbathing. As the day comes to an end and the sun sets of the beautiful Seychelles.
